## **Admissions Criteria**

1. First Place Academy expects exemplary behavior and attendance from its students. Applicants must have commendable behavioral and attendance records to be considered for admission.

### **Step 1: APPLICATION**

- Completed Student Application
- \$200.00 non-refundable application fee
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card of student and parents.
- Copy of Drivers license of both parents
- Immunization Record on HRS-680 form
- Physical on HRS-3040 form (must be within 12 month of the first day of school)
- A signed acknowledgement of receipt of our disciplinary practices, parent handbook
- Signed Waiver of Liability and Release

### **STEP 2: ADMISSIONS & FAMILY CONFERENCE**

The purpose of the family conference is to explain the mission and expectations of the school and allow parents the Opportunity to share their expectations and personal walk with Jesus Christ. This mandatory meeting takes place after all paperwork and testing has been completed and is for parents and students. The staff will work with you in choosing a date that fits into your schedule and that of the school administrator.

### **STEP 3: ADMISSIONS**

- The Administrative Staff will prayerfully consider your child's application.
- Students may be refused admission for various reasons including, but not limited to, unavailability of classroom space, poor scholastic performance, or ongoing disciplinary problems. Admission cannot be granted until all necessary records have been turned in to the school office and the personal interview completed.
- Continued enrollment is contingent upon proper attitudes, conduct, and academic progress.
- You will be notified in writing of the admission decision. Upon acceptance, a \$200.00 enrollment deposit is required to hold a place for the student. This deposit will be held for the duration of enrollment.

### **STEP 4: ENROLLMENT**

Upon acceptance to First Baptist Academy, the above 3 steps must be completed and received in the office before your student is officially enrolled.

Once your student has been accepted to First Place Academy photos will need to be taken for your id badges. The final step in the enrollment process is paying any and all fees. Payments must be kept in advance of any services rendered. If Payment is not received on Friday for the next week a \$25.00 late fee will be assessed on Monday.

Please contact the school office for scholarship and financial aid assistance. Many of our students are able to attend at no cost or at a significantly lower cost to the parents. Please also be aware that most of the scholarships and financial aid is on a first come first serve basis and many have deadlines that must be met.

**DEPOSIT:**

Upon acceptance, a deposit of \$200.00 is required to reserve placement.

**TUITION POLICY:**

Our parents understand that tuition and other fees are necessary in order for First Place Academy to successfully fulfill its mission. They commit themselves to promptly meet their financial obligations in accordance with Biblical stewardship. They also understand and agree to comply with the following tuition policy:

- The semester’s tuition is due if a student withdraws after the beginning of the school year because the hiring of teachers and staff and the ordering of textbooks and other classroom materials are based upon anticipated enrollment. Student records will not be released until the account is paid in full. Parents will be expected to honor their full year’s commitment to the school. Requests for exceptions must be addressed in writing and will be considered on a case-by-case basis. The best time to withdraw a student would be at the end of the semester to have the least amount of impact of charges or records being held.
- Tuition that becomes 30 days past due could result in the student being subjected to termination from the school until such amounts due to First Place Academy are made current.

## STUDENT CONDUCT

### Philosophy

As students of First Place Academy, you have a daily opportunity to practice the biblical principle of obedience to authority by your cheerful and prompt obedience to every member of the faculty and every staff member of First Baptist Church. Because griping and complaining are in direct opposition to God’s Word, these behaviors will not be tolerated. You are welcome to express your concerns and questions regarding First Place Academy policies, in a respectful manner, to your Principal or teacher at any time. Because we are committed to partnering with your parents for your spiritual success, we will diligently strive to train you in the following very important character traits: *self-control, discipline, personal responsibility, and proper response to authority*. “Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you...” Hebrews 13:17. “Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world.” Philippians 2:14-15.

### General Behavior Standards

Attendance at First Place Academy is a privilege – not a right. Accordingly, you are expected to conduct yourself in an orderly and respectful manner at all times.

Please do not bring on campus books, music, magazines, binders, folders, lunch boxes, or any other materials that depict or glorify anti-Christian characters or philosophies. Please do not place any of these inappropriate items in your backpacks, binders, lockers, or notebooks. “And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.” Ephesians 5:11-12.

### Classroom/Chapel/Assembly Standards

1. You are expected to attend all assigned classes, chapels, and assemblies. You are expected to arrive on time, to bring all the necessary books and materials, to be attentive, to fully participate, and to apply yourself diligently in order to learn.
2. You are encouraged and expected to offer complete obedience and respect to all your teachers, all other faculty, and chapel leaders at all times.
3. You are not to bring any candy, food, or drink into any classroom or chapel service; you are not to eat or drink in any classroom or chapel service except as part of an official school function.
4. **You may not chew gum** anywhere on campus anytime during regular school hours or during official after-school activities on campus.
5. **You are expected to keep your hands to yourself.**

Outside Standards The key words for outside (and especially playground) behavior: COURTESY, SAFETY and CHEERFUL SUBMISSION TO AUTHORITY.

1. You are encouraged and expected to *walk* on campus (*except where appropriate on the playground*.)
2. You are encouraged and expected to talk in a normal tone of voice (*No yelling*.) and to avoid excessive noise (*No slamming locker doors*.) (Please remember that we share this campus with many other ministries.)

3. You are encouraged and expected to keep your hands to yourself. *(No physical contact between boys and girls; no hitting, slapping, or kicking.)*

Serious Offenses: As students of First Place Academy, your behavior and attitude directly or indirectly affects the public Christian testimony of First Baptist Church, First Place Academy and our Lord Jesus 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. As such, the following behaviors are strictly forbidden at all times, on and off campus. Your participation in these or similar behaviors will result in severe discipline, up to and including suspension or dismissal from First Place Academy.

1. Physical fighting.
2. Possession and/or use of weapons on school property; use of weapons in any dispute.
3. Stealing or attempting to steal.
4. Deliberate destruction of church, school, or personal property, or acting as accomplice to such action.
5. \* Possession, use, disbursement, or sale of narcotics, alcohol, tobacco, or any illegal substance; possession, use, or disbursement of any controlled substance without a doctor's prescription.
6. Lying or cheating in any form.
7. Profane or obscene language.
8. Moral behavior that defiles the testimony of First Baptist Church and School.
9. Sexual immorality as defined in the Scriptures.
10. \* Possession, use, or disbursement of pornography, or any vile, obscene, or profane literature.
11. \* Possession, use, or disbursement of materials, devices, or products that endorse, encourage, or promote immoral behavior.
12. Endorsement and/or promotion of anti-Christian philosophies or behaviors.

**\* These offenses carry an automatic suspension of at least one full semester.**

(For any action that includes a violation of criminal law, the proper law enforcement authorities will be called and asked to take appropriate legal action.)
